

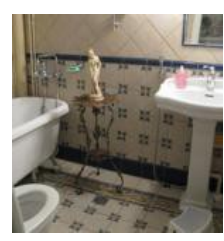
LA BICHETTE

La Bichette is located in idyllic Villerville, "the nearest beach" from Paris (200 km) on the Cote de Fleurie, close to the spa towns of Deauville, Trouville and Honfleur. La Bichette itself is a three bedroom house rich with historical and artistic atmosphere. La Bichette is located right at the ocean: just 1 min (100 metres) walk to the beach! It offers a wonderful stay in the Calvados area.

Bathroom and kitchen are newly renovated, guests can cook fresh fish from Trouville market or self-picked mussels from the beach at the low tide. It's a wonderfully authentic experience in a house with over 150 years of history.

The village has a grocery store, post office and a few restaurants. Nearby there is a golf course and riding opportunities.

Deauville Train Station is 6 km from the property. Free Wi-Fi.



The area is idyllic and the location is perfect: it's an excellent base for exploring Normandy.

Down stairs:

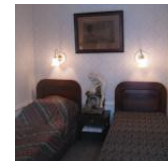
Livingroom, dining area, Bathroom with a toilet, Kitchen, utility room with a toilet. 1st Floor: 3 x Bedroom and a terrasse.

REVIEW:

I have been staying in this wonderful house several times in different seasons, alone and with large family, sometimes working (ie. writing), sometimes for a holiday, and I've loved it every time.

Villerville is an idyllic, tiny village with a couple of restaurants, pharmacy and a grocery shop, and you will enjoy just staying in it's calming atmosphere. But it's also an excellent spot for exploring Normandy, for ex. the famous beaches and markets of Trouville-Deauville or the impressionistic Honfleur.

La Bichette, the house itself, is absolutely cute and has everything you need - comfortable bedrooms upstairs, a newly renovated kitchen and bathroom, and the best of all: a historical feeling with it's beautiful antique furniture. The location of the house is just fabulous: as soon as you open the door you can feel the sea breeze, and it takes about 1 min to walk to the beach - I could spend my days just watching the sea, it's ever changing tides and sunsets, on every weather, stormy or sunny.

If you prefer to stay in stylish but sterile hotel rooms, which look the same everywhere around the world, this is not your place, the 18th century walls might not be perfectly straight, but you will definitely get something else instead. But if you're looking for a deeper experience in a house with over 150 years of history, a homey atmosphere, cultural richness and artistic inspiration, this is your place. This is for you who like to have an authentic experience of life at the Atlantic shore. This is for you, who like to cook your "sole" fresh from Trouville market in your own kitchen after spending the day at the beach, or even pick your own bowl of "moules" mussels at the beach. This is for you who like to walk in the evening barefeet from your door to watch the sea just one more time before getting to sleep.

THE BEACH and THE NATURE

The beach at low tide.

It has been described or painted by many writers, painters and engravers whose Valere Lefebvre and Emile Gaudrier (late nineteenth century).

Sand and shingle beach.

Magnificent views of Le Havre and Cape Hève.

Promenade: fitted along the beach and in the Graves.

Church of Our Lady (part of the XII). It houses four paintings classified as objects to historiques10 Monuments.

Museum "Sea and Desert" (1993), which gathered some 5,000 shells and exotic animals.

TOWNS nearby



- Deauville is famous for its casinos and also around it accumulates in the autumn film festival. Deauville Beach Resort (6.4 km)
Check out the resort's Promenade des Planches, consisting of a wooded walkway parallel to the beach and huts dedicated to famous movie personalities.
- D-Day Museum (the Battle of Normandy) is presented in Caen (50 min)



- Honfleur (8 km) The medieval Viking town, very artistic atmosphere with galleries, museums etc.

The environment offers many enjoyable things:

- * **DELICACIES:** Genuine Camembert is produced in Normandy. Pont Eveque hometown is a short distance from Villerville. Follow trails through the Pays d'Auge to learn more about the local production of cider and the famous Camembert cheese.
In Villerville you can gather mussels (Moules) though the beach is at the low tide and prepare delicacies for yourself in your own kitchen. Sure, mussels and other seafood can be bought from voluminous fish market places and supermarkets.
- * **DRINKS:** Villerville is situated in the Calvados region. In the neighborhood there are numerous cider farms, which produce Cider, Calvados and previous intermediate form: pommeau.
- * **ARCHITECTURE:** Gothic churches, the traditional Norman half timbered houses and Trouville Beach villas, Honfleurs medieval wooden church and ancient cityhouses offers stunning architecture. The historic interiors can be explored in the Museums: The Shipowners 1700s home in Le Havre and a beautiful collectors home at Chateau de Vendeuve.
- * **ART:** Impressionism is "born" on the Cote de Fleurie (the flower beach) area: Claude Monet was taught by Eugene Boudin from Honfleur. Etretat scenery as well as the Musee Eugene Boudin (Honfleur) provide a true extract of impressionism starting points! And Of course Monet's home Giverny is a pearl. The Impressionist Master composer Eric Satie's House Museum in Honfleur describes the age of impressionism with music. The Museum of Modern Art in Le Havre is one of France's most prestigious art museums.
- * **ANTIQUITES** weekly changing, a plenty of shopping opportunities: clothes, jewelry, decorative items, novelties, souvenirs ... and treats! Ancient lovers and collectors brocante- and vide grenier-monitors are the real treasure houses.
- * **SPORTS** Nearby is a golf course, Tennis, Stand-up-paddle boards and horse riding opportunities.
